2nd Annual Portage Lake Ice Fun Fish hosted by the MCSFA - February 29th

Entry fee is \$5, this is an individual event not team event.

100% of entry money will be paid out for big fish determined by length in each of 5 categories. If we don't have a fish entered in a category the money will be split equally among the categories that have entries.

The selected categories are: Northern Pike, Perch, Bluegill/Sunfish, Walleye, and Whitefish/Cisco.

You may pre-register at Lakeside Treats and Bait in Onekama (across from the park) beginning February 21st. You may also register the day of the 29th at the boat launch in Onekama from 7am-8am. If you pre-register you must check in at registration the morning of between 7am-8am. If you do not check in, your fish will not be eligible for the event. This is to assure everyone is fishing Portage Lake.

RULES:

You must be registered by 8am on February 29th. All DNR rules apply. You must only fish Portage Lake in Onekama.

Once registered you may head out, drill holes, setup shanties, etc.. You may not begin fishing until 7:30am and must have all lines out by 2pm. Measuring to take place at Papa J's in Onekama beginning at 1:30pm. Fish must be measured by 2:30pm or they will not be entered. Please ONLY bring your biggest of each category. Payout will follow immediately after with the intention of being done shortly after 3pm.

Papa J's will be open as a warming shelter/bathroom plus provide hotdogs, chips, hot chocolate and coffee for all participants. They will also have a portable fire pit for warming. Feel free to hang around and socialize afterwards.
